The ESO employs approximately 80 full/part-time faculty and 37 support staff. The School has approximately 200 undergraduate full-time students; up to 50% of students are from outside the UK, mostly from the European Union but with some international students. All undergraduates join the four year Integrated Masters in Osteopathy degree programme (M.Ost), which provides hands-on experience within the School's established teaching clinic.

The ESO does not have special programmes for foreign students but has links with a number of osteopathic schools throughout Europe; the curriculum is delivered either through visiting lecturers or by seminars held for international students at the School's UK campus.
