



## Centre Ostéopathiques du Québec (COQ)

The Centre Ostéopathiques du Québec (COQ) has one location, established in 1985. It employs one full-time employee, one general manager (part-time), a part-time coordination committee, and one part-time head of clinical activities. Its faculty consists of 40 part-time teachers, clinical instructors, and assistants, and the school has 132 students and 202 graduates, primarily from within the province of Québec. The COQ's major activity is its osteopathic programme, and its objective is to offer high quality health services to the population. The COQ utilises proficient pedagogical methods and encourages the development of knowledge in the field of osteopathy.

The COQ is a non-profit organization dedicated to teaching osteopathy. The COQ participates in the growth of the osteopathic profession in Québec by offering a high quality osteopathic program. Its goal is to train competent, prudent, and efficient osteopaths. It firmly believes in the future of its profession in Québec. The COQ believes that the province of Québec benefits from a strategic position and must be a crossroad for osteopathy by integrating American and European practices.

The COQ sometimes has special programmes for foreign students, and has accepted some students from France. The COQ is endorsed by the Registre des Ostéopathiques du Québec (ROQ), and is an OIA member.
