The Osteopathic Cranial Academy is an international membership organisation with multiple locations, was established in 1947, and employs a staff of two. The Osteopathic Cranial Academy has a membership of 1,300 from twenty countries. The mission of the Osteopathic Cranial Academy is to teach, advocate, and advance osteopathy, including osteopathy in the cranial field, as envisioned by Andrew Taylor Still, MD, DO and William Garner Sutherland, DO. The vision of the Academy is to promote mastery in the practice of osteopathy in the cranial field, to support a vibrant professional environment so that osteopathy can flourish, and to establish osteopathy, including osteopathy in the cranial field, as a recognised cornerstone of complete patient care.

The Academy conducts a minimum of two forty-hour introductory courses in osteopathy in the cranial field, as well as other intermediate courses throughout the year. The Academy has conducted courses in other countries, and accepts foreign members. The Academy also hosts an annual conference for its members for educational purposes, and to conduct business of the Academy.

The Osteopathic Cranial Academy values its international scope and encourages membership. It has six international affiliate societies with others in consideration for membership. The term affiliate society means a registry, association, or other professional organisation approved by the Board of Directors. The International Membership subcommittee is currently co-chaired by Daniel A. Ronsmans, DO, of Belgium, and Mark E. Rosen, DO, FCA, of the United States.
