

Partner Profile: The European School of Osteopathy (ESO)

ESO is a member of the Osteopathic European Academic Network (OSEAN) and is dedicated to the provision of the highest quality in osteopathic under and post-graduate education and clinical care to the community and osteopathic research. The school is committed to the concern for the individual with respect to the origins and philosophy of osteopathy and the need to embrace the wider community of Europe and the world. ESO employs four full-time and approximately one hundred part-time faculty, along with thirty support staff. ESO has approximately 230 undergraduate full-time students, up to 50% are from the European Union, including some internationals, but mostly located in the southeast of England. All of these undergraduates join the Integrated Masters in Osteopathy Programme (M.Ost).

ESO's major activities revolve around Osteopathic education, including the work in a teaching clinic. They do not have special programmes for foreign students, but ESO has links with a number of osteopathic schools throughout Europe, and in some cases, delivering the curriculum by sending lecturers to those countries and receiving international students at their school for seminars.
