Registro Brasileiro dos Osteopatas - R.Br.O. (Brazilian Register of Osteopaths) is a nonprofit civil society, founded in 06/13/2000, in Rio de Janeiro, by a pioneering group of Osteopaths which has been advocating for more than twenty years for the recognition of Osteopathy as a profession and for its regulation in Brazil.

RBrO believes that Brazil should follow the path of other countries that consider osteopathy as a profession in its own right, rather just a branch of another health profession, operating under the guise of the same.

Due to RBrO's efforts the profession of osteopath was classified under the number 2261-10 in the CBO Codex - Brazilian Classification of Occupations that identifies occupations in the labor market and catalogs activities, training requirements, professional experience and working conditions in the country.

Bill for the regulation of osteopathy as a profession in Brazil was introduced in the Brazilian Chamber of Deputies in Brasilia on 28th November 2012, under the number 4771_2012 and the ongoing legislative process can be followed at:

The RBrO's main goals are:

- Osteopathy to be considered an independent profession
- Cooperation with international osteopathic associations
- Defense of the title of osteopath DO (degree in osteopathy)

RBrO is currently composed of Brazilian Osteopaths trained in Brazilian educational institutions and overseas, in countries where osteopathy is regulated as a profession, and members who practice osteopathy abroad besides the honored ones.
