



ISOstéo Lyon, Institut Supérieur d'Ostéopathie Lyon (ISO-Lyon)

ISOstéo Lyon was established in 1991. The school offers a 6-year full-time course after A-level (Baccalauréat) providing a French DO-TNO qualification. The school staffs about 100 employees, including approximately 20 full-time positions. The school has about 700 students, mostly from the East of France, and does not have locations in other countries.

ISOstéo Lyon objective is to offer high quality education to its students, relying on the teaching concept of clinical education participating in the progressive recognition of high level osteopaths in France.

The school's major activities include teaching theories and practices, and clinical teaching thanks to two teaching clinics (which have about 10,000 consultations per year) and internships (about 12,000 consultations per year). The school does not have special programs for foreign students at this time, but looks forward to organising exchanges with foreign schools.

ISOstéo created the label "Ostéopathe DO-TNO", so that osteopaths holding it can be recognised, by public institutions and patients, as highly-qualified professionals.
