Prevalence of osteopathic research publications in mainland Europe





Type of research ME

- 25% RCT (n=22)
- 75% non-RCT (n=67)
- based on data, the RR of publishing a non-RCT compared to RCT is 3.0 (95% CI 2.1 -4.5)


Question to ask before opting for an RCT...






How



- Multi-disciplinary 'international' COLLABORATION
 RR international authorships: 0.11 (0.06 0.21)
 RR different institutions/departments: 0.23 (0.20 0.27)
- increase the N of interventional high quality trial data suggests RR of publishing an RCT = 0.42 (0.35 0.51)
- significantly enhance quality of research
 [last estimates showed high risk of bias in the majority of studies]
- promote competences and culture with publications and dissemination







When




- By 2020, according to the main european stakeholders, significant improvements have to be put in place. Outcome measures:
 - N publications in high impact indexed journals (beyond osteopathic journals)
 - N of Innovative projects
- By 2023 according to the latest USA strategic plan



What (we have to do) ME

Decrease the gap between 'patients, researchers, health-care practitioners, stakeholders, policymakers' and osteopathic culture
