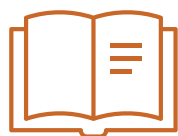

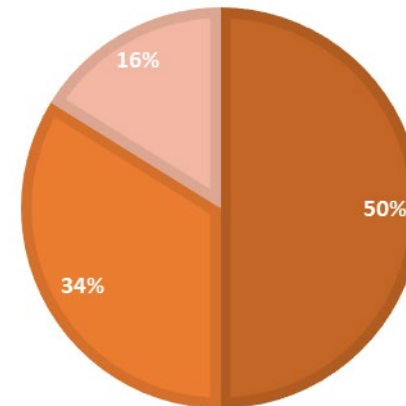
■ Revenues ■ Expenses ■ Net

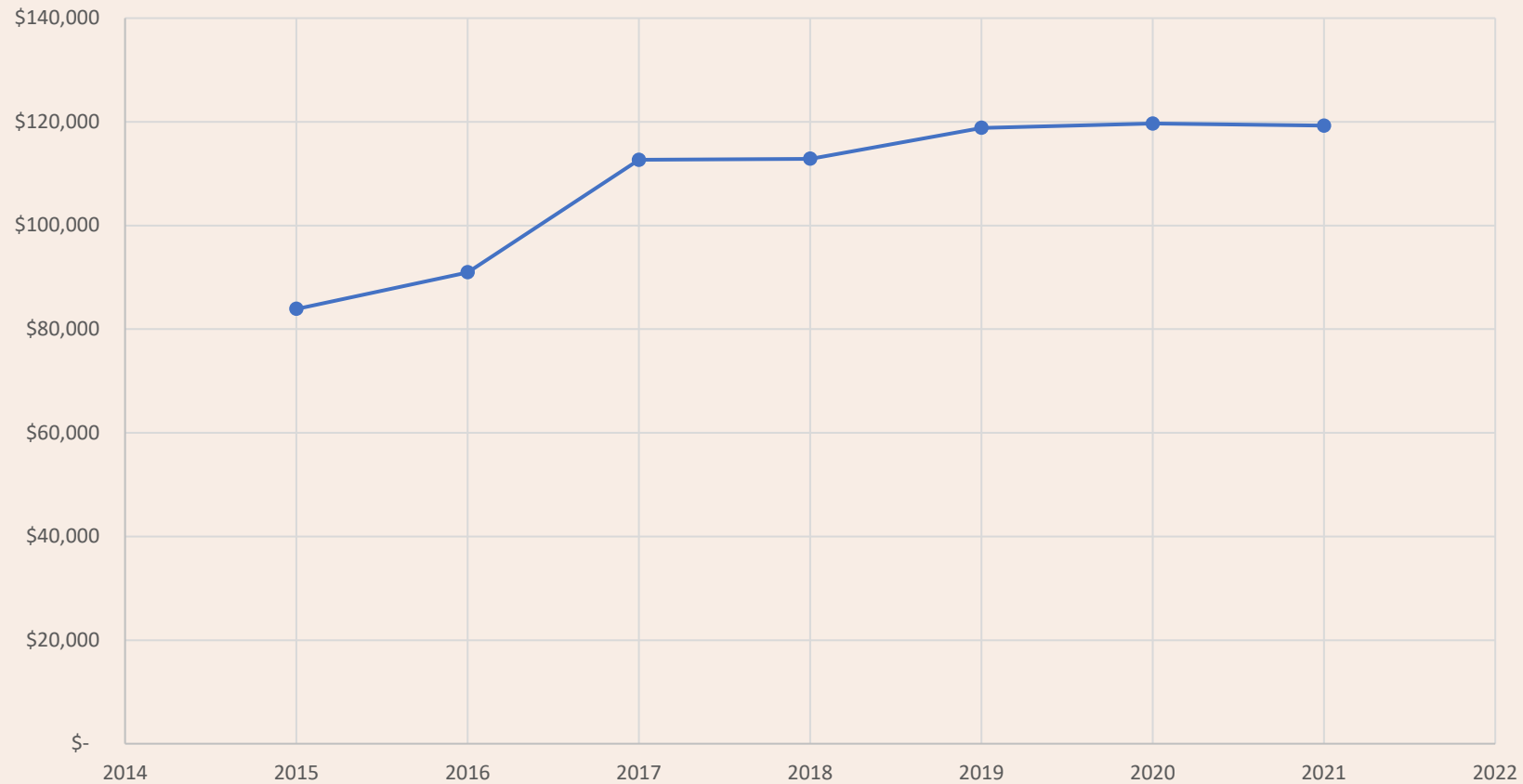

The OIA education standards are:

- **CEN, European Standard on Osteopathic Healthcare Provision - EN 16686**
 - Type I: no fewer than 4,800 h / no fewer than 240 ECTS / a Master's level qualification
 - Type II: adapted to prior curriculum with a minimum of 1,000 h of supervised osteopathic clinical practice
- **WHO Benchmarks for Training in Osteopathy**
 - Type I programme: 4,200 hours, at least 1000 hours of supervised clinical practice and training
 - Type II programme: typically 1,000 hours

An addition, the Board reserves the right to request external validation of a Partner applicant's curricula.
