Learning Opportunities and Qualifications in Europe



- Information about courses, work-based learning and qualifications
- levels in the European Qualifications Framework (EQF)
- The European Qualifications Framework for Lifelong Learning (EQF)
- EQF - defining eight levels of learning
- Each of the 8 levels is defined by a set of descriptors indicating the learning outcomes relevant to qualifications at that level in any system of qualifications.

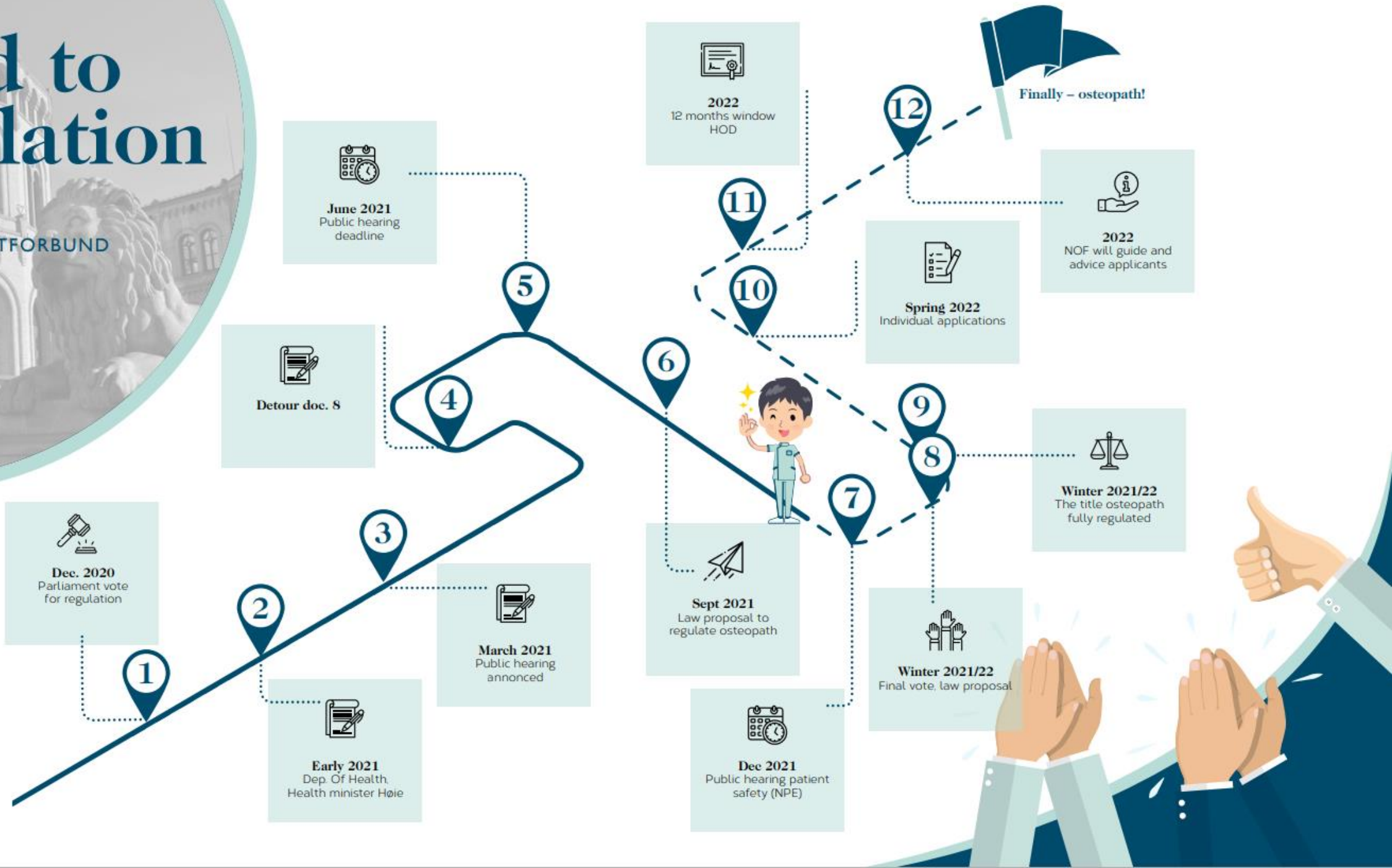


The Bologna Process and the European Higher Education Area

The main focus is:

- the introduction of the three-cycle system (bachelor/master/doctorate)
- strengthened quality assurance
- easier recognition of qualifications and periods of study
